

STEM Bridge Program FAQs

1. What is the STEM Bridge Program and why am I in this program?

The STEM Bridge Program is uniquely designed to help you in your goals for a degree in Science, Engineering or Computer Science. Admission into the program will give students an opportunity to enroll at FAU while adjusting to the rigor of college STEM coursework, focusing on academic success. Students are offered admission to Summer or Fall based on their overall academic profile.

Students offered admission for the Summer term will complete 6 credits in Summer Term 3 and continue into Fall as a part-time student (no more than 11 credits). Additionally, all Summer students will be enrolled into SLS1410: FAU iSucceed, fully online, 0 credit first-year experience course. Students admitted for the Fall term will complete no more than 11 credits as a part-time student.
